SUBJECT: School Year 2018-19 State English Learner Annual English Language

Proficiency Assessment Window: January 15 - February 26, 2019

The annual English Language Proficiency (ELP) assessment window for School Year 2018-19 will be held January 15, 2019 through February 26, 2019. The online ACCESS for ELLs must be administered to all identified English Learners (ELs) in grades K-12 to meet the requirements of Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA), reauthorized as the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA).

The Alternate ACCESS for ELLs for students in grades 1-12 who are classified as ELs and have significant cognitive disabilities that prevent meaningful participation in the ACCESS for ELLs assessment will continue to be available as a paper/pencil test.
